Frequently Asked Questions

When does the program start?

The program starts the 3rd Monday of every month.

How long does it take to get the visa? It typically takes 4-6 weeks to complete the enrollment process.

Is it hard to get the visa?

No, ATP will help you with every step. The process consists of a few applications and an in-person interview at a US Embassy.

Do you offer accommodation?

Accommodation is available in a nearby apartment complex, as well as area hotels.

Shortly after scheduling the program, an ATP representative will contact you to find out what assistance you need with accommodation, transportation, and anything else you need to assist with your transition to the US.

Is it possible to share housing with another student?

Yes. It may be possible to share housing with another student. It is important to contact your International Student Advisor as soon as possible. They will be able to contact other students to inquire if they are also interested in sharing housing.

What is a typical training day like?

Typically, you will have two flight activities per day. These activities can include flights, ground sessions, simulators/ FTD's, or a combination there of.

Is there a uniform policy?

Yes. All students are required to adhere to ATP's published uniform policy. This includes: ATP Dri-Fit Golf Shirt, tucked in; khaki, navy, or black chino pants or dress-shorts, with a belt; dress shoes or sneakers.

When should I arrive in Daytona Beach?

It is recommended that you arrive one week prior to your start date. This will give you the opportunity to become accustomed to the timezone and have your housing and other issues resolved before your start date.

Will I need transportation while training with ATP?

ATP is located within walking distance of your permanent housing. Some students buy cars, bicycles, or scooters, others walk to the facility. Transportation will be provided for you during the first two weeks for ATP related events such as FAA Medical Exam, TSA Fingerprinting, and from the Daytona Beach airport upon arrival (during regular business hours). Your International Student Advisor can assist you with transportation arrangements from other airports.

How to Get Started

Complete a Student Visa Application Form

International students who require a student visa will complete a Student Visa Application Form and make a \$1,400 USD payment as follows:

- \$400 USD non-refundable application fee.
- \$1000 USD first payment to reserve your class date. This payment applies to the course price, and is fully refundable if for any reason your Student Visa application is denied.
